



Rules for Young Scientists' Award of the 11th ECNP International Conference On Nanostructured Polymers And Nanocomposites

§. 1.

Young Scientists' Award

1. The Scientific and Organising Committees of the 11th ECNP Conference, being deeply interested in high level of young scientists research activities in the fields that are general topics of 11th ECNP intend to award the prizes for the best posters of the Conference.

§. 2.

Rules of granting

1. In the competition, young scientists (undergraduate, graduate and PhD students) who have been authors or co-authors of the submitted and accepted abstract and who have presented their studies during Conference Poster Session could participate.

§. 3.

Competition Organiser

1. The Organizing Committee is the body responsible for the competition organisation, as well as for an appointment of a jury.

§. 4.

Jury

1. The jury board consists of members of the Scientific Committee of the 11th ECNP Conference.
2. Each member of the jury selects the 10 best posters in his/her opinion and assigns them a score of 1 to 10, where 10 means the best poster.
3. The final result of evaluation process is the sum of points given by particular member of jury to individual posters.
4. The list of young scientists' is created according to the obtained final amount of points, wherein the best is the one with the highest number of points.

§. 5.

Sponsorship

1. Financial awards will be granted for outstanding contributions of young scientists, thanks to the sponsorship of Functional Composite Materials (FCM) Springer Nature Switzerland AG.

§. 6.

Amount of the Prize

1. Three awards for the best poster communications will be selected by scientific jury and announced during the Closing Ceremony or Conference Dinner of the 11th ECNP. The amount of the award is as follows:
1st - €250
2nd - €150
3rd - €100
2. Awarded scientists are not obliged to pay income tax in Poland (Journal of Laws 2022.2647, article 21, point 1, paragraph 68).

Final remarks

1. In matters not covered in this rules, the decision will be made by the Chairman of the Scientific Committee.
2. Organisers reserve the possibility to make changes or introduce additions to the rules of Young Scientists' Award.
