





Professor Marian Kryszewski 1925 - 2005

co-founder of the Polish school of polymer physics

Author of over 400 publications in renowned journals. Supervisor of 45 PhDs, including Andrzej Gałęski, Tadeusz Pakuła, Jeremiasz K. Jeszka, Jacek Ulański.

Head of Department of Physics (1958-1968) and Department of Polymer Physics (1969 – 1995) at Faculty of Chemistry, Lodz University of Technology

Co-founder of the Centre for Molecular and Macromolecular Studies, Polish Academy of Sciences in Lodz; Deputy Director for Research of this Centre (1972 - 1995) Member of Polish Academy of Sciences (since 1978)

Promoter of DMP and CMMS cooperation with University Lyon 1.

Author of pioneering works in the field of crystalline polymer morphology and correlation between supramolecular structure and physical properties of polymers.

Initiator of research in Poland on the dielectric, electrical and photophysical properties of polymers; his book "Semiconducting polymers" published in 1980 gained widespread recognition abroad.
